Oral Presenters



Presentation Schedule

- → As an oral presenter, you will have up to 15 minutes to present your work on a presentation and a few minutes for Q&A. Please follow the instructions from the session moderator. The International Scientific Committee have allocated your presentation in a session according to topics.
- → Your presentation date and time is already on the congress website.
- → Please check it out and make sure to attend the meeting room at least 15 minutes before the exact time.
- Following the session moderator's instructions, you will deliver your presentation to onsite audience.
- For the Q&A, the session moderator will collect all questions from onsite audience together and deliver to you after the presentation

Presentation File

- → You are required to bring your latest presentation file onsite. Please visit the congress preview room ahead of your presentation to prepare your presentation file ready in your meeting room accordingly.
- → You are able to download the congress standard power point template that can be accessed via the website. It is recommended to use this template.

Digital Proceeding

→ The Congress Proceedings compile all the papers (abstracts, full-papers, oral presentation files, and posters) submitted to the congress and accepted to be a part of the programme. Poster Presentation

- → Your presentation date and time is already on the congress website.
- → Each poster presentation has been allocated 15 minutes to present your work and have Q&A session.
- → You have to stand by in front of your poster display on time of your presentation date and time.
- → No country flag. Only name and surname, affiliation, organization.
- → The poster should be in English.

Poster display

- ★ As a poster presenter, you are required to print and bring the hard copy of your poster to the congress venue. You will have a designated place at the venue to display your poster.
- → The poster size must be 900 mm wide by 1.272 mm long. The dimensions relate to the physical space for poster display.
